- Fisher is home to a number of cross-disciplinary university centers
- Centers have been developed where academic strengths intersect with business practitioner interest
- Examples
 - Center for Operational Excellence
 - Center for Innovation Studies
 - Keenan Center for Entrepreneurship
 - National Center for the Middle Market
 - Nationwide Center for Advanced Customer Insights
 - Ohio State Center for Real Estate
 - The Risk Insitute



- Oldest example is the Center for Operational Excellence (COE), established in 1992
 - ✓ Operations was a historical research strength of Fisher but little faculty outreach to community
 - ✓ Apparent practitioner interest in recruiting and continuous learning
 - ✓ COE was established with a mission to promote research, student programs, and outreach to the community of practice
 - ✓ A corporate membership model was established with fees expected to assure financial stability
 - √ No College funds support COE
 - ✓ A small fraction of revenue goes back to the college



- Direct Benefits to the College and University
 - Income derived from member contributions
 - Increased Brand Awareness—improved rankings
 - Supports Land Grant Mission
 - Enables Student Internships and Jobs
- Indirect Benefits
 - Non-Degree Executive Education Programs
 - Practitioner Input to Curriculum
 - New Degree Program
 - Greater Community Support
 - Faculty Research Opportunities




