## 2010 Summer Research Experience Program at OSU

The CCTS Summer Research Experience Program (SREP) allows **high school students and teachers** to contribute to research studies being conducted at The Ohio State University (OSU) and Nationwide Children's Hospital. Each participant will be placed with a research team conducting health-related clinical and translational research. As active members of the research team, participants will conduct activities appropriate for their level of experience. Participants will be matched with host investigators based on participants' interests to the extent possible. All SREP participants will receive research-related and safety training during the first week of the program.

### Fast Facts

- Location:** OSU Campus and/or Nationwide Children's Hospital
- Hours:** 20 hours per week (high school students)  
20 or 40 hours per week (high school teachers)
- Timeline:** At least 7 weeks of work between June 14 and August 13, 2010. Attendance at training the week of June 14 and a poster session the week of August 2 are mandatory. Participants' schedules the rest of the summer will be negotiated with their host investigators.
- Pay:** At least minimum wage (\$7.30/hour) for high school students  
Competitive salary for high school teachers
- Transportation:** Participants must arrange their own transportation. Bus passes and temporary parking passes will be provided if needed.
- Age:** High school participants must be at least 16 years old. Students graduating from high school in June 2010 are eligible to participate.
- Other:** Preference will be given to students and teachers from Metro Early College High School, Eastmoor Academy, and Northland High School. Applicants from other central Ohio schools will be considered if space is available (especially those with backgrounds that are traditionally underrepresented in clinical and translational research).
- To Apply:** Applications will be available in late February and due in early April.
