Alburuj R. Rahman has been a participant of the summer sports camp, first in the National Youth Sports Program (NYSP) and later in NYSP's continuation to Life Sports, since 2004. This camp is held on the Ohio State University campus in Columbus, Ohio. This year, 2010, Alburuj has just finished his seventh year of participation. However, this year, his role was a youth leader for the group of 13 year old campers. I have been watching Alburuj all these years as he is growing to be a respectful young man.

Alburuj is an excellent and a most disciplined camper. He has always participated in all the sports and has put forth his full effort.
