Mental Health and the Workplace


- 18 percent of adults or nearly one in five suffer from 'any mental illness'" *National Institute of Mental Health, 2017*
- Roughly 4 in 10 adults with mental health disorders don't seek treatment SAMSHA 2016
- Outcomes in not treating Mental Health Issues :
- Worker Productivity absenteeism & presenteeism
- Heathcare costs medical and pharmacy because of co-occurring health disorders

According to the American Psychological Association, workplace was the third leading cause of stress (61%) after money (62%) and the future of the nation (63%).

>Managing stress is foundational to good mental health


- Train Managers, Supervisors and Coworkers on mental health awareness and how to identify when coworkers are struggling.



Ohio State EAP Executive Summary: January thru March 2019



Critical Incident Response (CIR) – Group debriefing available to units following a critical incident such as an unexpected death or workplace violence

Formal Management/Fitness of Duty Referrals – HR and Supervisors make formal mgmt. referrals to address an employee's performance. Fitness for Duty referrals is an assessment to determine one's ability to complete the essential functions of the job. Crisis Assessment Team – OSU initiated multi-disciplinary team to address workplace safety concerns <u>Consultation</u> – EAP professional provide regular immediate consultation to managers, HR and Leaders regarding critical incidents and employee performance concerns.
