

The presentation introduces the background and development of the "Oberlin Band," a group of missionaries with Oberlin connections that served and died in China. Beginning in 1881, the group came under auspices of the American Board of Commissioners for Foreign Missions and journeyed to Shanxi Province. It traces their activities in the province including street corner evangelism, medical work, opium refuges, education and work with women.
