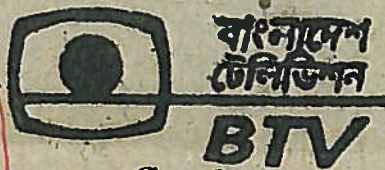

near a sluice gate of the area and sent it to the morgue of Dhaka Medical College Hospital (DMCH) for autopsy.

However, police failed to give details of his suicide.

In another incident, Shilpi Sarkar (18), daughter of Sudev Sarkar of Nazirerbagh under Keraniganj Police Station succumbed to her injuries at DMCH. Shilpi reportedly tried to hang with a rope from the ceiling of their residence following a family fued on Saturday last. She was shifted to DMCH, where she succumbed to her injuries early Saturday. Her body also sent to the DMCH morgue for autopsy.

Separate cases were registered with Lalbagh and Keraniganj police stations.
