SURVEY SUMMARY REPORT: WORKSHOP #6 MINERVA GRAND, HYDERABAD FEBRUARY 16 and 17, 2018

The WSR workshop #6 was a huge success, the students were waiting eagerly to meet with international experts. There were total of thirty-nine (39) participants – majority of the participants were college students and there were few high school students and teachers. The high school students along with their teachers traveled 20 km each way from Bollarum in Medchal district.
